Sunsail, Port Solent

By Train

The nearest main line station is Portsmouth & Southsea with regular connections to Chichester, Brighton, London and Southampton. The nearest local station to Port Solent is Portchester and the station at Havant is conveniently placed on the Network South East, London to Portsmouth Harbour Service. For information on local and national train times and fares telephone: 08457 484950 (24 hour service). There is a taxi rank at Portsmouth and Southsea train station.

Driving from the West

Leave the M27 at Junction 12. As you approach the traffic lights ahead stay in the left hand lane and proceed into the filter lane to the left, which adjoins the A27 eastbound. Pass through a number of sets of traffic lights and once you have driven under the motorway bridge proceed into the filter lane on your left hand side into the Port Solent Marina complex.

Driving from the East

Join the A27 and continue heading west. Immediately before the A27 becomes the M27, filter left down to the Hilsea roundabout when you see sign for Port Solent. Take the second exit off the Hilsea roundabout and continue until you reach the Marriott Hotel traffic lights. Stay in the middle lane and follow the road over. Pass through a number of sets of traffic lights and once you have driven under the motorway bridge proceed into the filter lane on your left hand side into the Port Solent Marina complex.

Driving from London

Travel towards Portsmouth on the A3 and continue on the A3(M). Take the right hand fork at the bottom of the A3(M) for the A27, marked Portsmouth & Southampton. Take the westbound A27 and follow the "From the East" directions.
